

**REQUIREMENTS FOR HONORS IN HISTORY/HISTORY OF SCIENCE,
MEDICINE AND TECHNOLOGY**

I. Achieve a GPA of 3.5 out of 4.0 in all history and history of science department courses AND an overall GPA of at least 3.3 in all courses taken at UW-Madison at the time of graduation.

II. Complete a minimum of 36 credits, distributed as follows:
a.) 5 courses in history

b.) 5 courses in history of science, of which 3 must be from the 300-599 series (substitutions may be accepted at the discretion of the history of science honors advisor)

III. Complete at least 21 credits of upper-division and/or graduate-level work (300-999) in the joint major while in residence at UW-Madison

IV. Complete one of the following history of science courses:
180, 280, 284 (in conjunction with 212)

V. Complete 6-8 credits of Seniors Honors Thesis in History 681-682 **OR** History of Science Senior Honors Thesis 681-682. Students choosing History 681-682 must take History 680 both semesters in conjunction with the thesis. If you choose History of Science you must take History of Science 555 before embarking on your thesis; in exceptional cases, it may be taken in conjunction with 681.
