Purpose: The Mosse Distinguished Research and Service award (\$2,000) is designed to reward majors who have demonstrated excellence in historical research and undertaken significant community service at the campus, local, national or international level. The award funds students who need financial support to undertake significant community service oriented learning. In exceptional cases, the award could be given to a student who has already completed both a historical research project and a service project. Applicants should submit a detailed 3 page proposal that discusses both their research project and their proposed community service, along with a transcript and a letter of recommendation from a faculty sponsor.

Eligibility: University of Wisconsin-Madison undergraduates who plan to work in collaboration with a UW-Madison History faculty or emeritus faculty member are eligible. Students who are awarded other support for the same project need to notify the History Department.

Examples of Possible Community Service (not an exhaustive list):

- Participation in a service-learning course that provides intellectual and hands-on experiences that can be integrated into a historical research
- Volunteer for a community organization at the local, state, national, or international level whose mission, population served, or historical context provides material suitable for historical research
- Study or volunteer abroad programs that provide you an opportunity to further both your research project and community service commitment

Application: Please include **two** copies of the following:

- 1) Application Form
- 2) A detailed description of the research and community service learning project (no more than five double-spaced pages)
- 3) A UW-Madison transcript (official or unofficial)
- 4) A recommendation letter from a faculty member
- 5) A signed form or email from the community service organization with which you will be collaborating, indicating their support of your service learning project
