COURSE DESCRIPTION

Beginnings of the fur trade to the present with emphasis on political, social, and economic history since American occupation.

LECTURES

Class meets three times weekly. No discussion sections.

WRITTEN ASSIGNMENTS and EXAMINATIONS

Options according to student interest: book reports, topical or research essays. No assigned topics. Mid-term and final exams, generally essay type.

GRADING SYSTEM

Allows for mixed constituency. A small percentage of students normally from history majors, many from colleges other than Letters and Sciences. Based on exams and papers.

One text: Nesbit, Wisconsin, A History (UW Press, 1973). (Nothing else available published since 1940).
