FASCISM AND NATIONAL SOCIALISM IN EUROPE, 1914-1945

This is an undergraduate seminar in which each student is responsible for the following assignments:

- 1) Reading a weekly assignment in the preliminary text each week for the first six weeks, attending each meeting and participating in seminar discussion.
- 2) Writing a 20-page research paper. The topic for this paper must be defined in consultation with the instructor by February 12. During the second part of the semester each student will make a brief (20 minute) oral presentation of the main points of his/her paper. The first draft of at least 10 pages of the paper is due April 9. The full and final draft is due May 7.
