Requirements:

Four review essays of 1000 words (four double-spaced typescript pages). Each will cover two books selected from the appropriate sections of the bibliography. The first, due on Oct. 7, will include one book each from the General and Colonial Wars and the American Revolution sections; Oct. 21—Early Republic to the Civil War and Civil War; Nov. 4—1865 — 1917 and World War I to 1939; and Nov. 18—World War II and Korea and The Cold War and Vietnam. The term paper will be a review essay of 1500 words (six double-spaced typescript pages) on three books. Each student will also give an oral report on this paper.

Grading:

A maximum of 18 points for each regular paper and 28 for the term paper.
